We are instructed that on 19 August 2006 you attended at our clients' residence without prior arrangement, for the purposes of seeing your mother.


Whilst our clients have no objection to you seeing your mother, our clients do object to you showing up at their residence unannounced. We note that you simply entered our clients' property without consent.
